VC INTRODUCES SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Muhammed Salihu Audu, FMAN has introduced a scholarship scheme for students of the Federal University of Technology, Minna. He stated this during the orientation ceremony of 2011/2012 fresh students held recently at the University Auditorium, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

In his address, Prof. Audu said in order to motivate student towards excellence, the University is instituting "The Vice-Chancellor's undergraduate scholarship award," which entails exemption from payment of school fees, free hostel accommodation and a token for purchase of books.

The scholarship, he said will be for all students who make a CGPA of 4.50 and above at the end of

100 level and will last until they graduate as long as they do not drop below the stipulated standard.

Prof. Audu while welcoming the students said FUT, Minna is a centre of excellence and will in no way tolerate vices such as examination malpractices, cultism, drug peddling and addiction, rape, theft and admission fraud.

He advised the students to to work hard and noted that the University is always concerned about students' welfare as such students' hostels, lecture rooms, theater and halls were recently renovated to provide a friendly environment for learning.

In his remarks, the Dean, Students Affairs, Dr. Yahaya Iyaka, thanked the Vice-Chancellor for his presence and support adding that his kind gesture is a clear sign of his commitment to students.

He urged the students to make good use of the award being first of its kind in the history of the University.

During the ceremony, Heads of Schools, Centres, Units and the Student Union briefed the students on their various functions.

As part of efforts to minimize intra-University transportation problems faced by students at the Main campus, Gidan kwano, the Vice-Chancellor at the end of the ceremony launched four tricycles (Keke Napep) transport scheme.
