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FUT, MINNA HOSTS NURESDEF

ederal University of Technology, Minna collaboration with **National** Universities Commission (NUC) has hosted the 5th edition of Nigerian University Research and Development Fair (NURESDEF) tagged: Research and Development: A Road Map to National Transformation and Economic Prosperity.

At the opening session of the fair, held at the PTDT, Chemical Engineering Theater, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano, FUT, Minna VC, Prof. Muhammed Salihu Audu said that Nigerian Universities houses brains that can bring about the needed transformation in the country and called for more research funding.

He tasked industries operating in Nigeria to utilize the technical know how in Nigerian

Universities rather than running to developed countries for their researches and called for more funding of the NURESDEF fair from NUC to the host institution.

In his address, the Executive Secretary of (NUC), Prof. Julius Okojie who was represented by Deputy, Executive Secretary of the Commission, Mr. Akinbode Agbaoye said that the mission of NUC is to ensure the orderly development of a well coordinated and productive University system that would guarantee relevant education and qualitative research for national development and global competitiveness. One of such means according to him is the biennial Nigerian University Research and Development Fair (NURESDEF).

In his welcome remark, Chairman of the opening ceremony, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede who was represented by Prof. Folade, DVC (Research & Development), University of Ilorin commended the efforts of National Universities Commission (NUC) in promoting and encouraging research and development activities in Nigerian Universities through NURESDEF.

"I believe this fair would turn out to be stimulating and enlightening by the virtue of the wide array of exhibition on display" he noted.

Director General (DG), National Office for Technology, Acquisition & Promotion

(NOTAP), Dr. Umar Bubar Bindir at the opening session of the fair delivered a keynote address tagged: Research and Development: A Road Map to National Transformation and Economic Prosperity.

Dr. Bindir said that the academia should look beyond the conventional publication of books and journals gear towards promotion and invest in research that will lead to new inventions. The DG, also noted that science, technology and innovation are the bedrock of any society that is desirous of economy development and prosperity. He further called for collaboration between tertiary institutions and industries in Nigeria in order to achieve economy transformation of vision 20:2020 of the Federal Government.

Chairman, LOC, DVC (Academic), Prof. Akim Osunde said that the theme of the fair is timely in the light of the transformation agenda being pursued by the Federal Government and welcomed guests to the University. He also tasked participating Universities to listen attentively to the various papers presentation during the period of the fair.

NURESDEF is a platform created for Nigerian Universities to showcase their research findings and was first organized in 2004. The fair had over 20 Universities in attendance.

FUT, MINNA PARTNERS KARMA MILK IND. LTD IN SOYA BEANS, OIL PRODUCTION

Pederal University of Technology, Minna has agreed to partner with Karma Milk Industries Limited, Lagos in the production of soya beans and refined soya oil.

This agreement was reached recently during the signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between FUT, Minna and Karma Milk Industries Limited at the VC's Conference Room, Senate Building, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

Vice –Chancellor, Prof. Muhammed Salihu Audu (*FMAN*), while presenting a copy of the signed MoU, said that the University is happy to partner with Karma Limited and prayed for the partnership to grow from strength to strength.

"It is our plan to have a vibrant commercial farm in FUT, Minna and we are hoping for more partnership in other areas", Prof. Audu enthused.

In his remark, the General Manager of Karma Milk Industries Limited, Mr. Rajindra Kumar Tandon said that the company hoped to benefit immensely from the partnership in the area of cultivation of seeds for the production of soya beans and refined soya oil and that the company is ready to set-up a soya processing plant in Minna.

Earlier briefing Management on the MoU, the DVC (Admin), Prof. Abdullahi Bala said that Karma Milk Industries Limited could not get a land in Abuja and when approached; he invited the company to FUT, Minna.

"The mandate for production of seeds and certification is on going with the appropriate government agencies" he noted.

The company required 75,000 metric tons of seeds in order to produce 200,000 tons of soya beans and 50,000 tons of refined soya oil per year.
