#### PG PROF. ZUBAIRU PRESENTS **BOOK OF ABSTRACTS TO VC**

The Dean, Postgraduate School, Prof. ▲ (Mrs.) Stella Zubairu has presented a copy of the newly published FUT, Minna PG Book of Abstracts to the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Musbau Adewumi Akanji, FNSBMB.

The presentation took place on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 at the VC's Office, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

Presenting the book to the VC, Prof. Zubairu said the book contained abstracts written by students of the School since 2008 - 2012, aimed at enhancing effective abstract writing in the School.

She revealed that the book would be an annual publication and noted that PGS would soon commence production of Newsletter aimed at publicising programmes and activities of the school to the people.

The Dean further stated that the first edition of the Newsletter would feature personality profile on the University POs while nothing that the Newsletter would be a Quarterly publication.

Responding, Prof. Akanji thanked the PG School for actualizing the production of the book and noted that the book was long overdue.

The VC directed the Dean to send an electronic copy of the book to the Web-Content Committee for upload on the University website which he said would boost the institution's webo – metric rating and to all Postgraduate Schools in the country.

The Dean later presented copies of the book to the Registrar; Mrs. Victoria Kolo, Bursar; Mr. Mufutau Alabi Bello and University Deputy Librarian; Dr. (Mrs.) Juliana Udensi.

The book comprises of M.Tech and Ph.D Theses written by students of the School since 2008 till date and was edited by Dr. Evans C. Egwin.
