As part of efforts to provide access to e-library resources, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Muhammed Salihu Audu, has officially flagged off the Systems Unit Laboratory equipped with 50 desktop computers and six laptops.

An HP DL 380 GT server is also part of the new facilities as well as an inverter which will ensure steady electricity in the unit.
