CCCFR HOLDS 2ND DVARR CERTF TRAINING

The Director, Centre for Climate Change and Fresh Water Resources (CCCFR), Prof. Abubakar Ahmed Sadauki has said that with the right machineries in place, there will be reduction on the effect of Climate Change on this part of the world.

Prof. Sadauki stated this on Wednesday, August 21, 2013 at the opening of a twoweek long Certificate training in Disaster Vulnerability Assessment and Risk Reduction (DVARR) being held at the College of Education, Minna.

While declaring the ceremony opened, the Vice-Chancellor of the institution, Prof. Musbau Adewumi Akanji, *ENSMEM*, represented by the Director, CCCFR Prof. Abubakar Sadauki said the importance of climate change cannot be overemphasized and urged participants to make good use of the training for the benefit of all.

The Vice-Chancellor also thanked the organizers for the good work and the Management of College of Education, Minna for providing the venue for the training.

Earlier, in his opening remark, the Director CCCFR, Prof. Abubakar Sadauki said the second edition of DVARR training is being taken to the Primary Schools which is the foundation level for easy understanding of the effect of Climate Change.

According to him, the essence of the intensive training is to enlighten the grassroots on the importance of the effect of Climate Change and at the end of the training, participants will be able to identify and reduce the risk of Climate Change in our environment.

Prof. Sadauki also disclosed that major related agencies who are stakeholders in climate change such as Ministry of Environmental, UNDP, NESREA, SEMA, NAIC, UBE and SUBEB have all shown interest in the programme.

Representative of the chairman, Niger State Universal Basic Education Board, Hajiya Amina NDatsu in her remarke said the partnership with FUT, Minn is a welcome development. She encouraged participants to go back to classroom and make an impact as schools are also affected by the effect of climate change through wear and tear as well as flooding.

In his vote of thanks, the Deputy Director CCCFR, Dr. Annanias Tswanya Yisa expressed gratitude to the Vice-Chancellor and his management team for their support. He urged the participants to participate fully and water down all the technical aspects of the training. The 2-week training is being organized by CCCFR in collaboration with Niger State Universal Basic Education Board for Primary School Teachers drawn from the four senatorial district of Niger State while the facilitators are research assistants who are non-academic staff.

NAH PAYS A COURTESY CALL ON VC

... Seeks Supports

The president Nigerian Association of Hydro-geologist (NAH), Dr. Idris Nda Abdullahi has solicited for the University Management support and cooperation to host their National Conference in the University which is coming up in November 3, 2013 this year.

This was disclosed on Tuesday, August 20, 2013 when he led his team members for a courtesy visit on the Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. A. Akanji in his conference room, main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

Briefing the VC, Dr. Idris Nda said that the association was inaugurated in 1991 with membership mostly from Federal Ministry of Water Resources and Rural Development, since then the chapter has been contributing to the development of Niger State and other surrounding states notably Kogi, Kwara, Katsina, Zamfara and Federal Capital Territory. He also said that about 70 - 80% of the staff in Geology Department of the University were already registered members.

He further said members has been rendering professional services and advice to government agencies, corporate organisations and federal government parastatals.

Dr. Nda reiterated that they assisted individuals in the areas of groundwater development through provision of boreholes (motorised solar and hand pump), spring development and feasibility studies for water retention structures.

He however, noted that their members were involved in the production of the national code of practice for drilling in Nigeria in conjunction with Nigeria Industrial Standard for the regulation of drilling practice in Nigeria. Also were fully involved in the search for Oil in Bida, in Niger State.

In his response, the Vice-Chancellor of the institution, Prof. Musbau Adewumi Akanji, *FNSMBM*, assured them that the University Management would give them all the necessary support and cooperation to host their National Conference scheduled to hold in November this year.

He further expressed appreciation to members for their effort to eradicate guinea worm through supervision of boreholes in the areas that were affected in Niger State.

Prof. Akanji call on members to continue with their good work for educating the people about their activities rendered in the society. He also thank them for visit.
