CHAPTER ONE

1.0 INTRODUCTION BACKGROUND OF THE STORY

1.5 DIFINITION OF TERM

- Pin code: The card that contains security to the online result checker. Usually of (6 digits and can only allow the same candidate to check his or her result 5 times.

CHAPTER TWO

2.0 LITERATURE REVIEW

The online result checker was first introduced by National Examination Council (NECO)Okonkwo{2002}. One of the objectives is the ease, the stress of students unfruitful effort to check their grade.

The creation of NECO was only the climax of a process that spanned over twenty years. NECO was eventually created in the Abdusalam Abubarkar Administration (1999). NECO have proved to its standard, technologically for all other examination organization that have been in existence since NECO begin.

2.1 INTERNET AND RESULT CHECKER

The internet is a conglomeration of computers that are connected via telephone cables and satellite links around the world. It is a vast source of constantly changing and expanding information. Since it inception in the 1960's, the internet has grown astronomically and it is now used by million of people from those in commercial and educational institution to individual consumers.

The communication protocol, or "rule" used to route the packers across the internet is TCP/IP (Transmission Control Protocol/ Internet Protocol). Used of this standard protocol "rule" enables computers using different operating systems to communicate with each other. Dos-Base, PCs, PCs using the Microsoft Windows 95/98, or Windows NT Operating

System, Macintosh Computer and UNIX-Based systems all use and understand TCP/IP to connect and communicate with each other on the internet.

Once you connect to the internet, interact with others computer using a Client/Server model. The resources of the internet – information in service; are provided through host computer, that stores information such electronic mail, data based information or text files. The students as a customer or client "Client", you access these resources via client programs (application) e.g. Microsoft.

2.2 WEB BROWSER

A web browser is a client program (application) that is used to display the information provided by a specific server to which you are connected. It helps you to view and navigate through the information on the internet. Today most popular web browsers, including Quarterdeck Mosaic, Netscape Navigator, etc, offer a GUI (Graphics User Interface) to the World Wide Web. The web explorer guide {may 1999}.

The internet can be broken up into three different areas, namely:

- Internet Platform Providers
- Internet Service Providers
- Subscribers

1. Internet Platform Providers

Platform Providers are organization that provides the connectivity platform of the internet. They are first level in the internet hierarchy that establish connectivity to your local internet service provider via satellite links or underwater cables. These connections enables two-way communication for dial-up connections and data download on the internet, they are measured in band widths of a certain number of bits per second. For example, the platform provider may have two Megabit per second bandwidth, which it then sells to various internet service providers in cheeks from 64 kilobits seconds upwards.

Bandwidth

Bandwidth describe how much data that can be transmitted per second over the internet. Bandwidth is calibrated in bits per second (bps), kilobits per second (kbs), or megabits per second (MBPS). The amount of bandwidth you have available through your internet service provider will determine how quickly you will be able to access or download data or the internet.

2. Internet service providers (ISPs).

Internet service providers are the second tier of the internet hierarchy. They use the bandwidth they have purchased from internet

platform providers in order to offer connectivity service to subscribers via dial-up account.

3. Subscribers

Subscribers from the third tier of the internet hierarchy:

They obtain connectivity to the internet via different connection mechanisms.

Ways of connecting to internet

- Modem analogue dial-up accounts

The most widely used method is through a modem, which connects your computer to a normal telephone line, which in turn connects to a modem at the host computer. This is called a dial-up account, because your computer goes through a process similar to dialing a phone number in order to gain access to the internet via a web server hosted by your ISP. All dial-up connections require the internet protocol and are therefore called IP accounts. PPP, which stands for point – to – point protocol, is the standard connection of choice because it is fast and reachable. The speed at which information is downloaded to your computer is defined by the speed of your dial-up modem. The most commonly used modem speeds are 33.6 KBPS or 57.6 KBPS.

- Fast dial-up connection (ISDN).

The second method of dial-up connection to the internet does not involve traditional modems and is referred to as an ISDN line connection. Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) is a Tele communication service that connects through digital lines using a "terminal adapter". ISDN provides a faster connection and can be more economically if it is available in your local area code. With an ISDN line you only pay for the time you are physically downloading, sending or receiving data. Windows 95/98 offers driver to support ISDN. If you want as ISDN line, you need to apply to your telecommunications provider to install it, and your connections speed can be as fast as 128kbps.

The advantages are that where a standard telephone line can traditionally carry only voice, or one fax "conservation", an ISDN line can support up to three separate "conservation" at once, through standard copper lines in the same sections. As many as 8 separate devices such as telephone, computer, fax, video phone, CAN etc, can be connected to the individual ISDN lines and each can be allocated a separate number.

Why is ISDN faster than 'normal' telephone line?

The two basic reason why the digital connect is faster than the analogue connection are

- Digital signal ignore the static and noise that normally affect the analogue transmission, especially over long distance and older lines, producing exceptionally high quality connects.
- Digital connections carry data at significantly greater speed and these will get even better as digital compression and other technology become available

What you need to get connected?

To get connected, you will need the following;

- A personal computer (Pentium III or higher recommended) running windows 95/98 with Dial-Networking so that you can get up your internet connection.
- Minimum RAM requirement should be 12MB, and 16MB with windows desktop update.
- Free Hard drive space: 56-98MB
- A modem (28.8Kpbs minimum speed) try and purchase a modem that can be upgraded to a faster speed or buy the highest speed modem you can afford.
- An account with a reputable 15p which has adequate bandwidth and infrastructure.

- Hypertext transfer protocol (HTTP)

Is the standard language that allows web clients and servers to communicate. Sometime www servers are called HTTP servers. Every www universal resource locator (URL) address starts with "http" e.g. http://www.neco nigeria.org

Hyperlinks: web sites use hyperlinks to display links to other pages. By clicking on there links, you can go directly to other pages or sites on the web. With hyperlinks you don't need to know where the worked document is located. It could be stored on a local computer or it could be on a computer halfway around the world.

Understanding web Addresses or URLs

The first part of a URL indicates the access method of protocol used by that server. For instance, all web sites would have a URL that begin with "http", since that is the protocol for accessing the web: Address http://www.neconigeria.org.ta/script/neconigeria/default.cop

The second part of the URL is the computer's domain name, which is described below. E.g. http://www.msn.com is the URL for the web page about the Microsoft Network (MSN) online service. The www indicate that this is a web Home page; MSN is the name selected by Microsoft for this site; the com indicates that this is in the commercial domain of the internet.

The last component, the pathname, identities the location of an item on the server. For example, a pathname usually specifies the possibly

preceded by one or more directory name (folder names) in which the file is stored (such as /home/welcom.htm).

Some pages have a as p(Active server page) file extension and are seemed by a Microsoft web server, which allows web developers to add facilities such as personification, entranced functionality and the ability to access services such as data basics that reside in the server.

CHAPTER THREE

3.0 ANALYSIS & DESIGN

Analysis of system is the focus of system developing and is the stage when system designers have to at two levels of definitions regarding the study of situation issues and possible solutions in "what to do "and "how to do".

3.1 REVIEW OF THE EXISTING SYSTEM.

Actually the existing system is manual. That is to say that most of the computation, manipulation and comparison of data during the computation processes are being carried out manually the system is therefore found to be facing the following problems.

- Errors in the compilations: checking result manually hand caused a
 lot of students been expelled from higher institutions due to the fact
 that of the operations are done manually.
- Reliability and security: the problems of errors in compilation depends on the reliability and integrity of the final result. In fact, because of the nonchalant attitudes of some school principal candidate subject-result (grade) many be given for another subject (grade).

- Lateness in the release of SSCE results: Another major problem of this system, is that most of the time results are not released on time.
 In fact in most cases results are not released until the results lost it credibility.
- 4. Problem of cost: since the most of the processes are manually carried out, there is need to involve many people at each stage of the compilation processes and also a lot of stationeries are required.

3.2 UNDERSTAND WHAT THE EXISTING SYSTEM IS DOING

The manually compilation of result checker had been the normal way of checking result until the advent of NECO. The students pay and sit for the SSCE examination, the release of result then the candidate traveling to their respective schools to check for their result-going through the school results & regulation, stresses on the road while traveling to school, mistake of the school principal in result compilation, the delays which may take couples of days during compilation of result is inevitable.

The students have to buy NECO online pin card. Then, set his registration number and so to any internet café, visit http://www.neconigeria.org and wait for message then enter your registration number followed by pin-code.

This automatically displays the student's results and the hard copy can be printed.

3.5 SYSTEM DESIGN

It also allow for scratching, up dating, sorting, promoting and making some mathematical calculation.
