Applications are invited from qualified candidates for admission into the One-year Preliminary Degree programme for 2017/2018 session and Interim Joint Matriculation Board (IJMB) programme for 2018/2019 academic session of the Federal University of Technology, Minna. The University runs various Science and Technology based degree programmes in the following Schools: (1) **Agriculture and Agricultural Technology**; (2) **Engineering and Engineering Technology**; (3) **Environmental Technology**; (4) **Entrepreneurship & Management Technology**; (5) **Information & Communication Technology**; (6) **Life Sciences**; (7) **Physical Sciences** and (8) **Science and Technology Education**.

Entry Requirements

To qualify for admission, a candidate must have at least five (5) credits to include **English Language, Mathematics** and any three of the following subjects: **Physics, Chemistry, Economics, Biology/Agricultural Science/Health Science and Geography at SSCE, GCE O' Level, NECO and NABTEB**. The results obtained should not be at more than two sittings. For IJMB programme, **Agricultural**

Science and Health Science are not acceptable.

Candidates are to log on to F.U.T., Minna website (www.futminna.edu.ng) to obtain instructions for the purchase of application forms.

The application form costs five thousand Naira (**N5,000.00**) only, excluding bank charges.

b. IJMB - 15th August - 15th November, 2017
