Between 1979 and 1984, Udensi had taught Physics at Secondary School, Advanced Teachers' College and University levels. He joined the services of the Federal University of Technology, Minna as an Assistant Lecturer on September 24, 1984.

He has held several position of responsibility in the University, among which are: Head of Department, Physics; Chairman, University's Seminar and Colloquium Committee and Director, Advancement and Development Office (ADO). He also served as Chairman of ASUU in the University.

He is happily married with children.
